2025 Spring Semester Policy

Welcome to my studio. I am excited to be a part of your music education! Please read the following thoroughly.

Tuition:

- There will be a total of 15 lessons this semester beginning the week of January 20. Each lesson is 30 minutes. When you register and a time has been confirmed, you are agreeing to pay for the entirety of the semester. If you choose to withdraw before the end of the semester, you will still be obligated to pay for the remaining tuition.
- There are two options for lessons my studio/virtual or the student's home. Full tuition can be paid on the first lesson in January or monthly payments due the first lesson of each month (Jan. May). Price will be prorated if the start date is after January 20th.
 - My studio/virtual: Total is \$375 for the semester or \$75 a month (This breaks down to \$25 per lesson.)
 - Your home: Total is \$450 for the semester or \$90 a month. (This breaks down to \$30 per lesson.) For households with more than two students, each additional student will be discounted to a tuition of \$375 per student.
- Cash or checks are preferable. PayPal is also an option. Paypal transactions will be charged an extra 2%.
- Late payments made more than 7 days from the due date will be assessed a \$10 late fee per student.

Attendance:

- A calendar for the current semester is provided on the website. I recommend printing it for your reference.
- If lessons are missed and unable to reschedule during the week, make-up lessons will be provided May 12th through the 29th. If no make-up lessons are needed, lessons during that time can be paid for on a weekly basis.
- Any lessons I miss will be made up within the makeup time frame or reimbursed.

Materials:

- Material fees are included in the tuition. This covers teaching supplies, recitals/parties, website, and the virtual platform.
- Children will need one plastic folder with brads or a 1 inch 3 ring binder to be used as an assignment book. I provide the assignment pages. Adults may use any type of notebook.
- Students will be responsible for any books and supplies that need to be purchased. Links will be provided for items to be purchased from www.amazon.com.

Weekly Responsibilities:

- Children are expected to practice 5 days a week. The amount of time each day will be determined by myself and the student. A consistent practice schedule will ensure faster progress. Adult practice time will be determined based on your schedule.
- Depending on the age of the student, parents may need to be actively involved in their child's practice routine.
